

ORDINANCE NO. 02-578

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 5-206 (2) OF THE FRIEND MUNICIPAL CODE REGARDING SPEED LIMITS; TO ADD PROVISIONS REGARDING THE SPEED LIMITS ON STREETS OTHER THAN THOSE ORIGINALLY DENOTED; TO REPEAL ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH; AND TO PROVIDE FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FRIEND, NEBRASKA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Section 5-206(2) of the Municipal Code of the City of Friend, Nebraska, be amended as follows:

(2) The following speeds shall be prima facie lawful, subject to the provisions of subsection (1):

(a) Fifteen miles per hour within the congested district which shall include that portion of the Municipality within the following bounds: Main, Maple and Chestnut Streets from the south side of First Street to the south side of Third Street; and Second Street from the west side of Main Street to east side of Chestnut Street.

(b) Twenty miles per hour on Second Street from Chestnut Street to Vine Street.

(c) Twenty-five miles per hour outside the congested district of the City.

(d) On First Street, more commonly known as Highway Six, forty-five miles per hour from the City limits on the West end of town to Cedar Street and from the City limits on the East side of town to Spring Street.

(e) On First Street, more commonly known as Highway Six, thirty-five miles per hour between the streets of Cedar Street and Spring Street within the Corporate Limits of the City of Friend, Nebraska.

Section 2. That all ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby specifically repealed.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect after its approval, passage, and publication according to law.
