RESOLUTION NO. 04-07

WHEREAS, Section 5-403 of the Municipal Code of the City of Friend, Nebraska provides that the City Council may by resolution set aside any street or portion thereof where the parking of vehicles shall be prohibited; and

WHEREAS, it is deemed necessary to so designate certain areas indicated below within the City as no parking areas for the protection of the public;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FRIEND, NEBRASKA as follows:

No parking of any vehicle of any type shall be allowed on the east side of Pine Street for a distance of 194 feet north of the north curb of Sixth Street at anytime. No Parking signs shall be located in the necessary manner to so identify and designate this area, as well as necessary curb painting.

Councilperson Fricke moved the adoption of said Resolution. Councilperson Tuttle seconded the motion. Upon vote the following Councilpersons voted aye: Weber, Kunert, Tuttle, Fricke. Nays: none. The Mayor declared Resolution 04-07 adopted.
