



RESOLUTION #03-18-A


A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FRIEND, SALINE COUNTY, NEBRASKA, APPROVING THE APPLICATION OF THE FRIEND VOLUNTEER FIRE DEPARTMENT, FOR A SPECIAL DESIGNATED PERMIT UNDER THE NEBRASKA LIQUOR CONTROL ACT, TO SELL AND/OR DISPENSE LIQUOR, BEER AND WINE AT THE FRIEND COMMUNITY BUILDING, 147 MAIN ST., FRIEND, NE AT AN ANNUAL MEMORIAL WEEKEND DANCE TO BE HELD ON MAY 24, 2003 TO MAY 25, 2003 IN THE CITY OF FRIEND. THE SAID SPECIAL DESIGNATED PERMIT TO BE LIMITED TO THE INSIDE AREA AND THE OUTDOOR FENCED-IN AREA OF THE FRIEND COMMUNITY BUILDING LOCATED AT 147 MAIN ST. FOR SAID MEMORIAL WEEKEND DANCE, TO BE HELD BETWEEN THE HOURS OF 8:00 A.M. ON SATURDAY, MAY 24, 2003 AND 1:00 A.M. ON SUNDAY, MAY 25, 2003, PURSUANT TO THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF FRIEND, AND THE NEBRASKA LIQUOR CONTROL ACT.




