

RESOLUTION NO. 01-05

WHEREAS, Section 7-301 of the Municipal Code of the City of Friend, Nebraska (1999) provides that the City Council may prescribe rules, regulations and precautionary actions as they deem necessary pertaining to the storage or keeping of poisonous or flammable gases or liquified petroleum gas within the city limits and zoning jurisdiction of the city; and

WHEREAS, it is deemed necessary to mandate maximum tank sizes for the storage of liquified petroleum gas (propane) within certain areas of the city, and the color of those tanks;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FRIEND, NEBRASKA as follows:

1. No tank used for the storage of liquified petroleum gases (propane) for residential or any other usage with a capacity in excess of 150 gallons shall be permitted within the R-1 and R-2 zoning districts of the municipality. All such tanks shall be painted with a white, non-reflective paint.

Councilperson Horner moved the adoption of said Resolution.

Councilperson Tuttle seconded the motion.
