RESOLUTION NO. 00-05

WHEREAS, Section 5-205 of the Municipal Code of the City of Friend, Nebraska (1999) provides that the City Council may, by Resolution, provide for the placing of stop signs, or other signs, signals, standards or other mechanical devices in any street or alley or portion of any street or alley for the purpose of regulating or prohibiting traffic thereon, and

WHEREAS, it is deemed necessary to place the following signs on the streets hereinafter designated in the City of Friend, Nebraska;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FRIEND, NEBRASKA as follows:

A. "STOP" signs shall be installed on Main Street at its intersection with 5th Street. These signs shall be permanent, and shall replace the existing STOP signs currently located at this location.

B. "STOP" signs shall be installed on Pine Street at its intersection with 3rd Street. The current "YIELD" signs located on 3rd Street at its intersection with Pine Street shall be removed.

Councilperson Himmelberg moved the adoption of said Resolution.

Councilperson Tuttle seconded the motion.
