

RESOLUTION NO. 00-26

COUNCIL PERSON Himmelberg introduced the following resolution:

WHEREAS, The City of Friend intends to refund a previous bond issue, and pay capital project expenses through debt financing not previously budgeted, and;

WHEREAS, these changes will cause an increase of \$1,060,000 in both budgeted receipts and disbursements, and;

WHEREAS, these increases necessitate an amendment to the fiscal year budget for 1999-2000 of the City;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FRIEND, NEBRASKA as follows:

That the fiscal year 1999-2000 budget of the City of Friend, Nebraska, a municipal corporation, is hereby amended, as to the general fund, to allow for additional receipts in an amount not to exceed in the aggregate, the sum of \$1,060,000, and to allow for additional disbursements in amounts not to exceed, in the aggregate, the sum of \$1,060,000, and that all remaining provisions of said budget are affirmed and ratified in all respects except as to the above amendments.

Councilperson Himmelberg moved the adoption of said Resolution.

Councilperson Gill seconded the motion.

The Mayor declared the Resolution adopted.
