RESOLUTION NO. 00–33

WHEREAS, Section 5-407 of the Municipal Code of the City of Friend, Nebraska (1999) provides that the City Council may by resolution prohibit the parking or stopping except for loading or unloading of passengers or freight of vehicles at the curb on streets directly in front of any entrance to a school house or school building, and

WHEREAS, Section 5-205 of the Municipal Code directs that the City Council may by resolution provide for the placing of signs or signals in any street under the jurisdiction of the City for the purpose of regulating traffic thereon, and

WHEREAS, it is deemed necessary to so prohibit such activities in certain areas designated below within the City, and place signs or signals so indicating such prohibition at the appropriate locations;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FRIEND, NEBRASKA as follows:

- A. A Loading Zone is hereby designated along the north side of 6th Street, beginning 50 feet west of the west curb of Main Street and continuing in an uninterrupted manner west to a point 15 feet east of the east curb of Pine Street. Signs shall be installed at such location designating the area as a Loading Zone, and the curb along the north side of 6th Street shall be marked for the entire area with green paint to designate the Loading Zone. It shall be unlawful for any person to stop, park, or leave standing any vehicle at such loading zone for a period of time longer than is necessary for the expeditious loading and unloading of passengers, merchandise, or materials, and in no event for a period longer than 10 minutes.
- B. A No Parking Area is hereby established in an area commencing 50 feet west of the west curb of Main Street, extending continuously to the west curb of Main Street. Such area shall be marked by a sign indicating "No Parking to Corner" and painted red to indicate such prohibition.

Councilperson Bulwan moved the adoption of said Resolution.
Councilperson Himmelberg seconded the motion.
