

RESOLUTION NO. 00-34

WHEREAS, Section 5-208 of the Municipal Code of the City of Friend, Nebraska (1999) provides that the City Council may by resolution designate any area of a roadway as a school crossing zone through the use of an acceptable sign or traffic control device; and

WHEREAS, it is deemed necessary to so designate certain areas indicated below within the City as school crossing zones for the protection of the public;

WHEREAS, it is necessary to amend Resolution 00-34, passed and adopted on November 7, 2000, to insert additional and necessary language regarding the locating of cross walks and stop signs, and eliminate other language which was erroneous;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FRIEND, NEBRASKA as follows:

A. A School Crossing Zone is hereby designated at each of the following locations: along Main Street between 4<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> Streets, along 6<sup>th</sup> Street between Pine and Main Streets, and on the intersections of 5<sup>th</sup> and Main Steets, 6<sup>th</sup> and Main Streets, 5<sup>th</sup> and Pine Streets, and 6<sup>th</sup> and Pine Streets. Stop signs shall be installed at such locations, and cross-walks shall be painted at each location to protect the pedestrians using these areas.

Councilperson Horner moved the adoption of said Resolution.

Councilperson Fricke seconded the motion.

RESOLUTION NO. 00-34

WHEREAS, Section 5-208 of the Municipal Code of the City of Friend, Nebraska (1999) provides that the City Council may by resolution designate any area of a roadway as a school crossing zone through the use of an acceptable sign or traffic control device; and

WHEREAS, it is deemed necessary to so designate certain areas indicated below within the City as a school crossing zone for the protection of the public;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FRIEND, NEBRASKA as follows:

Incorrect

A. A School Crossing Zone is hereby designated at each of the following locations: along Main Street between 4<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> Streets, along 6<sup>th</sup> Street between Pine and Main Streets, beginning 50 feet west of the west curb of Main Street and continuing in an uninterrupted manner west to a point 15 feet east of the east curb of Pine Street. Signs shall be installed at such location designating the area as a Loading Zone, and the curb along the north side of 6<sup>th</sup> Street shall be marked for the entire area with green paint to designate the Loading Zone. It shall be unlawful for any person to stop, park, or leave standing any vehicle at such loading zone for a period of time longer than is necessary for the expeditious loading and unloading of passengers, merchandise, or materials, and in no event for a period longer than 10 minutes.

B. A No Parking Area is hereby established in an area commencing 50 feet west of the west curb of Main Street, extending continuously to the west curb of Main Street. Such area shall be marked by a sign indicating "No Parking to Corner" and painted red to indicate such prohibition.

Councilperson Gill moved the adoption of said Resolution.

Councilperson Himmelberg seconded the motion.
