

COUNCIL PERSON Himmelberg introduced the following resolution:

WHEREAS, Section 2-157 of the Municipal Code of the City of Friend, Nebraska provides that the City Council may, by Resolution, provide for the placing of stop signs, or other signs, signals, standards or other mechanical devices in any street or alley or portion of any street or alley for the purpose of regulating or prohibiting traffic thereon, and

WHEREAS, it is deemed necessary to place the following sign on the street hereinafter designated in the City of Friend, Nebraska;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FRIEND, NEBRASKA as follows:

A. "STOP" signs shall be installed at the Southeast corner and the Northwest corners of the 2nd Street and Cherry Street intersection directing traffic approaching from the North and South on Cherry Street to stop prior to entering the intersection with 2nd Street.

Councilperson Himmelberg moved the adoption of said Resolution.

Councilperson Tuttle seconded the motion.

The Mayor declared the Resolution adopted.
