A RESOLUTION AMENDING THE TRAFFIC CONTROL RESOLUTION SO AS TO PROVIDE FOR THE LAWFUL PLACEMENT OF ADDITIONAL SPEED CONTROL SIGNS ON STATE STREET TO WARN THE MOTORING PUBLIC OF THE "REDUCED SPEED AHEAD" FROM SOUTH TO NORTH, TO BE PLACED ON THE SOUTH CITY LIMITS ON STATE STREET, AND OF CHILDREN CROSSING SIGNS CONTROLING BOTH NORTH AND SOUTHBOUND TRAFFIC ON STATE STREET AND THE INTERSECTIONS OF THIRD AND FOURTH STREET.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL to hereby provide for the lawful placement of additional speed control signs on State Street to warn the motoring public of the "Reduced Speed Ahead" from South to North, to be placed on the South city limits on State Street, and of Children Crossing signs controling both North and Southbound traffic on State Street and the intersections of Third and Fourth Street.
