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## EMERGENCY RESOLUTION OF NECESSITY

WHEREAS, this is a Resolution of the Mayor and City Council of the City of Friend, Saline County, Nebraska, authored and passed on August 6, 1991 at the regular City Council meeting.

WHEREAS, a Resolution of the Mayor and City Council of the City of Friend, Saline County, Nebraska declaring an emergency and setting forth the necessity for entering into a contract with Werner Construction, Inc. of Hastings, Nebraska, for the blacktop overlayment of previously paved streets in the City of Friend, to-wit: From the intersection of 6th and Maple Street, south 970 feet by 24 feet; from the intersection of 6th and Maple Street to the intersection of 6th and Main Street, 340 feet by 24 feet; from the intersection of 2nd and Pine to the intersection of 2nd and State Street, 924 feet by 26 feet, and the intersection from 5th and Race Streets West 961 feet by 23 feet for the reason that said concrete has cracked and worn considerably but can be repaired by the use of asphalt overlayment; that the said Mayor and City Council of the City of Friend informally received bids for said hauling and laying of said overlayment and in the alternative for hauling the overlayment and the City performing the laying of the overlayment and finds that the bid of Werner Construction, Inc. of Hastings, Nebraska is the lowest qualified bidder in the amount of \$32,725.00; that an emergency exists for the reason that said pavement is a hazard to the traveling public and is in danger of deteriorating even further than it already has and for the reason that Werner Construction, Inc. has been working in the immediate area of Friend, and can perform the work immediately.

IT IS THEREFORE RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Friend that the informal bid of Werner Construction, Inc. of Hastings, Nebraska in the amount of \$32,725.00 is accepted for hot mix asphalt overlayment on previously paved portions of the intersection of 6th and Maple Street, south 970 feet by 24 feet; from the intersection of 6th and Maple Street to the intersection of 6th and Main Street, 340 feet by 24 feet; from the intersection of 2nd and Pine Street to the intersection of 2nd and State Street, 924 feet by 26 feet, and the intersection from 5th and Race Streets, West 961 feet by 23 feet.
