SUPPLEMENT TO MOTOR VEHICLE PARK RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION TO ESTABLISH DISABLED AND HANDICAPPED PARKING PLACES AND AUTHORIZE THE ISSUANCE OF CITATIONS AND FILING OF COURT PROCEEDINGS FOR COLLECTION OF FINES AND COSTS FOR VIOLATION THEREOF

IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL AS FOLLOWS:

1. Disabled and handicapped parking is hereby established and is to be marked by the occupied wheelchair sign authorized by the State of Nebraska for disabled and handicapped parking at the following places:
 - a. One parking place nearest the corner at the West entrance to the First National Bank Building, at the intersection of Second and Maple Street;
 - b. One parking place nearest the corner at the East entrance to Johnson's Pharmacy at the intersection of Second and Maple Street;
 - c. One parking place on the North side and in front of the Friendship Terrace on the South side of Second Street, between the sign at the U.S. Mail Box and the sign West of there, opposite the East line of the alley, one-half block East of Second Street and Summer Street;

2. It is hereby declared to be unlawful for vehicles not displaying the State of Nebraska disabled and handicapped parking permit, to park in any parking space having the restricted parking sign above described in Paragraph 1, and violators shall be issued a citation and prosecuted, fined and ordered to pay costs as authorized in Article III, Section 2-301 of Ordinance Number 400, passed and adopted on September 2, 1975.
