A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FRIEND, SALINE COUNTY, NEBRASKA OPPOSING BUDGET CUTS WHICH WILL AFFECT THE SALINE COUNTY AREA TRANSIT TRANSPORTATION SERVICE ALSO KNOW AS THE HANDY BUS SERVICE.

IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Friend, that they are opposed to any proposed budget cuts with regard to the Saline County Area Transit Transportation Service, also known as the Handy Bus, which are proposed by the present Republican Administration in Washington, D.C.; that the program and the service rendered thereby is absolutely necessary for the health and welfare of the elderly citizens of the rural areas in Nebraska and that the funding should be maintained in the same level that it has in the past for operational purposes.
