§ 131.01 DISCHARGE OF FIREARMS.

It shall be unlawful for any person, except an officer of the law in the discharge of official duty, to fire or discharge any gun, pistol or other fowling piece within the city, except that nothing in this section shall be construed to apply to officially sanctioned public celebrations if the persons so discharging firearms have written permission from the City Council.

§ 131.02 SLINGSHOTS; AIR GUNS; BB GUNS.

It shall be unlawful for any person to discharge a slingshot, air gun, BB gun or the like loaded with rock or other dangerous missiles at any time or under any circumstances within the city.

§ 131.99 PENALTY.

(A) Any person, or any person's agent or servant, who violates any of the provisions of this chapter, unless otherwise specifically provided herein, shall be deemed guilty of an offense and upon conviction thereof shall be fined in any sum not exceeding \$500. A new violation shall be deemed to have been committed every 24 hours of failure to comply with the provisions of this chapter.

(B) (1) Whenever a nuisance exists as defined in this code, the municipality may proceed by a suit in equity to enjoin, abate and remove the same in the manner provided by law.

(2) Whenever, in any action, it is established that a nuisance exists, the Court may, together with the fine or penalty imposed, enter an order of abatement as a part of the judgment in the case. (1999 Code, § 6-401) (Ord. 00-20, passed 6-6-2000)
